Based on the provisions of Article 21 of the Statute of the Aspira College of Applied Sciences and the Rulebook on rewarding students

OPEN CALL
on awarding students for the academic year 2025./2026.

(1) Awards and recognitions are awarded to undergraduate and graduate students of the Aspira University of Applied Sciences for exceptional success in the academic year, special success in sports, art, culture or other activities that are important for the work of the University as well as for an exceptional engagement in extracurricular activities and for the best student works and projects.

(2) Awards and recognitions are awarded to students in three categories:

a. The best grade point average in a particular study (Dean's Award):

- The prize for this category is awarded on the basis of academic success in the previous academic year (weighted grade point average must be above 4.0) that the student achieved during his studies and on the basis of overall engagement in teaching and extracurricular activities.

- Students who are enrolled for the first time in the year are entitled to the Dean's Award, unless they completed their studies at Aspira in the previous academic year, as well as students who have duly fulfilled all their student obligations stipulated in the Executive Plan and Program, who have passed all the exams they have entered and who, with their overall attitude towards their study obligations and colleagues, were an example to other students of Aspira.

- If several students have the same average, priority is given to the student who during the academic year achieved a higher percentage of attendance at classes and other curricular or extracurricular activities and did not repeat a single exam.

b. Exceptional involvement in extracurricular activities:

- The award for this category is awarded to students for special engagement and contribution to the work of Aspira, i.e. to those students who are exemplary in class and properly fulfill their student obligations and who have excelled in sports, artistic and cultural activities and competitions and/or volunteered or organized volunteer and humanitarian work and/or won an international or national award and/or actively participated in student associations

and/or participated in the organization of workshops, educational excursions, forums, round tables, etc.

c. The best student work or project:

- The award for this category is awarded to students who are authors or co-authors (with a mentor or fellow student) of one or more scientific or professional papers published in a categorized publication, which is not a seminar or final paper, and/or to students who participated in registration and implementation of a student, national, international or EU project, and/or students who presented at a scientific or professional meeting

(3) The same student can register in several categories and be awarded in several categories.

(4) In each category, one prize is awarded to a student of each undergraduate program and one student of each graduate program of the Aspira University of Applied Sciences.

(5) No prizes will be awarded for categories in which there are no registered students or for which the registered students do not meet the requirements.

(6) Candidates can submit their applications for the competition to student departments no later than **September 18th, 2026. at 4 p.m.** in a sealed envelope, in which he will enclose:

- an indication of which of the categories the student is applying for
- other documentation that proves the fulfillment of the conditions for the applied category (such as transcripts and average grades; description and confirmation of extracurricular activities at the University; international or state award; certificate of volunteering or organization of volunteer and humanitarian work; proof of active participation in student associations and/or participation in the organization of workshops, educational excursions, forums, round tables, etc.; professional and scientific papers that were published in a categorized publication in the past academic year; confirmation of registration and implementation of a student, national, international or EU project, and/ or about a presentation at a scientific or professional meeting; etc.)

(7) All timely and complete applications received are considered by the Committee on Student Awards. Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.

(8) Prizes will be awarded by the Dean to students at the commencement ceremony of the academic year Opening ceremony or at another appropriate event. The award is given in the form of a written acknowledgment and a suitable gift.
